American Government and Politics

Introduction:

The United States is the world's largest and most successful developed country. This course begins by introducing and interpreting the American Constitution to help students understand the historical background, basic processes and main contents of the Constitution of the United States, and the constitutional changes. On this basis, the course introduces and discusses the main processes of civil liberties and civil rights, political parties, interest groups, elections, legislation, administration, judiciary and public policy-making in the United States. The focus of the course is to learn, understand and grasp the American Constitution and the constitutional system.
