Dr. WANG Shaoguang is Chairperson and Professor of Department of Government and Public Administration, CUHK, and the Director of the Universities Service Centre for China Studies. He is also a Changjiang Professor in the School of Public Policy and Management at Tsinghua University, non-official member of the HKSAR's Commission on Strategic Development, and chief editor of *The China Review*, an interdisciplinary journal on greater China. He taught at Yale University in the United States from 1990 to 2000. His research interests include political economy, comparative politics, fiscal politics, democratization, and economic and political development in former socialist countries and East Asian countries. In addition, he has contributed to numerous edited volumes and journals.

Stanley Rosen (骆思典)

Stanley Rosen was the Director of the East Asian Studies Center at USC's College of Letters, Arts and Sciences from 2005-2011, and is a professor of political science specializing in Chinese politics and society. He studied Chinese in Taiwan and Hong Kong and has traveled to mainland China over 45 times over the last 30+ years. His courses range from Chinese politics and Chinese film to political change in Asia, East Asian societies, comparative politics theory, and politics and film in comparative perspective. The author or editor of eight books and many articles, he has written on such topics as the Cultural Revolution, the Chinese legal system, public opinion, youth, gender, human rights, and film and the media. He is the co-editor of *Chinese Education and Society* and a frequent guest editor of other translation journals. His most recent books include *Chinese Politics: State, Society and the Market* [Routledge, 2010] (co-edited with Peter Hays Gries) and *Art, Politics and Commerce in Chinese Cinema* [Hong Kong University Press, 2010] (co-edited with Ying Zhu). Other ongoing projects include a study of the changing attitudes and behavior of Chinese youth, and a study of Hollywood films in China and the prospects for Chinese films on the international market, particularly in the United States, film and society in China, and higher education reform in China.

In addition to his academic activities at USC, Professor Rosen has escorted eleven delegations to China for the National Committee on US-China Relations (including American university presidents,

professional associations, and Fulbright groups), been an invited observer for legislative, mayoral and presidential elections in Taiwan since 1991, and consulted for the World Bank, the Ford Foundation, the United States Information Agency, the Los Angeles Public Defenders Office and a number of private corporations, film companies, law firms and U.S. government agencies.

Guo Qi XU (徐国琦)

Professor Xu Guoqi is currently a professor at Department of History, the University of Hong Kong. He received his Ph.D from Harvard University and is one of the world's most prominent scholars in the fields of modern China and international history. His recent publications including the following:

Strangers on the Western Front: Chinese laborers in France during the Great War and their role in China's search for Internationalization (Harvard University Press, February 2011, Chinese edition will be forthcoming from Shanghai People's Press); *Olympic Dreams: China and Sports, 1895-2008* (Harvard University Press, April 2008); *China and the Great War: China's Pursuit of a New National Identity and Internationalization* (Cambridge, UK and New York: Cambridge University Press, February 2005 and September 2011; Chinese edition by Sanlian Shudian, Shanghai, August 2008 in its series of classics in humanities); *Wenming de jiao rong: diyi ci shijie dazhan qijian de za fa huagong* (Chinese Laborers in France during the First World War) (in Chinese and French editions) (Beijing: Intercontinental Press, November 2007); and *Meiguo waijiao zhengce shi* (History of American Foreign Policy, 1775-1989) (in Chinese, co-author) (Beijing: The People's Press, 1991). Besides academic writings, Professor Xu has also written for main media in the world and his articles have appeared in places such as the New York Times and Washington Post. He has been often interviewed by world media in China, Canada, UK, India, USA and elsewhere.

Bei Dao (北岛)

北岛，原名赵振开，一九四九年生于北京。早年做过建筑工人、编辑、自由撰稿人等。一九七八年，他和芒克在北京创办一九四九以来第一份非官方文学杂志《今天》，一直担任主编至今。自一九八七年起他在欧洲和北美居住并任教。获得多种国际文学奖和荣誉，包括美国艺术文学院终身荣誉院士和布朗大学荣誉博士。他的作品被译成三十多种文字。除多卷诗集外，还出版了小说集《波动》，以及散文集《蓝房子》、《午夜之门》、《时间的玫瑰》、《青灯》和《城门开》等，并和友人共同编辑出版了《七十年代》、《暴风雨的记忆》等书。自2007年起和家人移居到香港，在香港中文大学东亚研究中心任讲座教授。

一. 香港天气

一月份香港气温在 15~20℃之间，请注意保暖。香港天文台网站每天发布未来七天天气预报，建议出发前先查阅：<http://gb.weather.gov.hk/contentc.htm>。

二. 入境及前往香港中文大学


从中国内地来港，可以乘坐火车或飞机。乘飞机可以选择从深圳入境，也可以乘坐国际航班直达香港赤腊角机场。香港中文大学靠近深圳，从内地来由深圳入境可以节省交通费。

- **乘坐火车到深圳。**火车站出来就是罗湖口岸。入境后乘东铁线火车，约 25 分钟左右即可抵达“大学”站。头等车厢设软座，双倍收费。进入时请务必刷八达通卡确认，以免被罚款。

- **乘坐飞机到深圳。**从机场出来，在 B 区第六出口乘坐 K568 小巴（8:00~23:30，机场—罗湖火车站），约 50 分钟抵达罗湖口岸，票价 20 元人民币。也可搭出租车到罗湖口岸，约 120 元人民币。

- **乘坐直通火车到香港。**在终点“红磡”站下车后，乘坐东铁线火车，在“大学”站下车即可，车费约港币 \$9 元。

- **乘坐飞机到香港赤腊角机场。**在机场乘坐 A41 号机场巴士（6:00~24:00）到沙田市中心（该站并非巴士终点站，请预先向司机告知下车地点）。机场到沙田需 40-50 分钟，车费为港币 \$22.3 元，不设找赎，或用“八达通”卡。于沙田下车后可搭出租车前往中文大学雅礼宾馆（约港币 \$60 元）；或乘东铁线火车，约 8 分钟左右即可抵达“大学”站。最快捷的方式是由机场搭出租车到中文大学雅礼宾馆，约 45 分钟，坐绿色出租车车费约港币 250 元，不要坐红色出租车（车费约港币 \$320 元）。出租车司机能操日常英语及普通话。

建议到达后即刻在火车站或香港机场以 200 元港币购买“八达通”卡，内含 50 元押金和 150 元可用值。该卡可用于乘坐火车、地铁、大小巴士，还可用于杂货店、超市购物和大学餐厅就餐，省却买票和找零钱的麻烦。此卡可反复充值，出境时退还卡上余款和押金。**但乘坐出租车需要付现金。**

四. 入校园、到大学宾馆、到中国研究服务中心和会场

乘东铁线到达中文大学。东铁线“大学”站有两个出口，请从 A 出口进入校园。如果要直接前往雅礼宾馆，如没有手提电话，请在出站前使用投币电话（HK\$1/5 分钟），联络大学宾馆服务台 2603-6411，**请宾馆派小巴来接您。**并请出站后在遮雨长廊处等候宾馆小巴。通常，您的行李放在身边，宾馆小巴司机会很容易认出您。（注意：宾馆是 24 小时可登记入住，但宾馆免费接送车服务时间为早上 8 时-晚上 10 时 45 分，如果来访时不是这个时段，介时请您乘坐出租车直接到大学雅礼宾馆登记入住便可）。

若从大学站直接去中国研究服务中心（田家炳楼 8 层）或祖尧堂（大学行政楼），可在校巴总站搭乘免费校巴，在第二个经停站“邵逸夫堂”站下车，向图书馆方向步行约 200 米即到。**有关更多校内免费校巴的资料，请浏览网页：http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/transport_unit/**

乘坐出租车到中文大学。可要求司机将您送到指定地点（如雅礼宾馆、大学行政楼、田家炳楼等）。

从大学出行。雅礼宾馆设有专车定时开往大学火车站，时刻表会放在宾馆房间内。从祖尧堂/中国研究服务中心，或者雅礼宾馆往返于大学车站，步行下山一般需要 10—15 分钟，上山时间更长；也可乘往返于山顶和大学站之间的免费校巴，上下班高峰期连续发车，其它时间约每 20 分钟一趟，夜间 11 点后停开；或者叫大学宾馆（2603-6411）派小巴接送；也可在大学正门外等候出租车，或者请大学宾馆（2603-6411）代为招上门出租车外出或去机场。地铁或火车一般到夜间 12 点或稍晚停开，尽量不要错过，否则可能需要搭乘出租车返回学校。

五. 其它事宜

校内就餐：晚餐可在范克廉楼内各膳堂或者其它餐厅自理。早餐可于雅礼宾馆内、范克廉楼内各膳堂自理。雅礼宾馆服务台有详细校内就餐地点和地图。

校内购物、购书：午餐厅范克廉楼周围设有百佳小超市、书店、大学礼品店、理发店、银行等服务。

上网、复印：雅礼宾馆提供免费上网服务，具体联机说明放在房间内；如有技术困难，请咨询宾馆服务台；如需借用转换插头，亦请联络宾馆总台。

中国研究服务中心备有两台公用电脑可上网。中心提供复印服务（每页港币 4 角，用“八达通”卡付款）；中心开放时间为：周一至周五 9:00—17:50；周六 9:00—12:15。

港币兑换：入境口岸、机场皆有专门兑换点，需收取手续费。有银联标记的信用卡可以在大多数 ATM 机直接支取港币（会收取手续费）。部分购物场所可以直接使用人民币消费。

长途电话：如需拨打长途电话，最省钱的办法是在罗湖口岸或香港机场购买本港的电话储值卡。储值卡附增一个本港的 SIM 卡，可直接插入手机使用。不同的电讯服务商，价格不相同，购买时请小心咨询。致电中国大陆，最便宜大约是每分钟 0.20-0.25 元港币。
